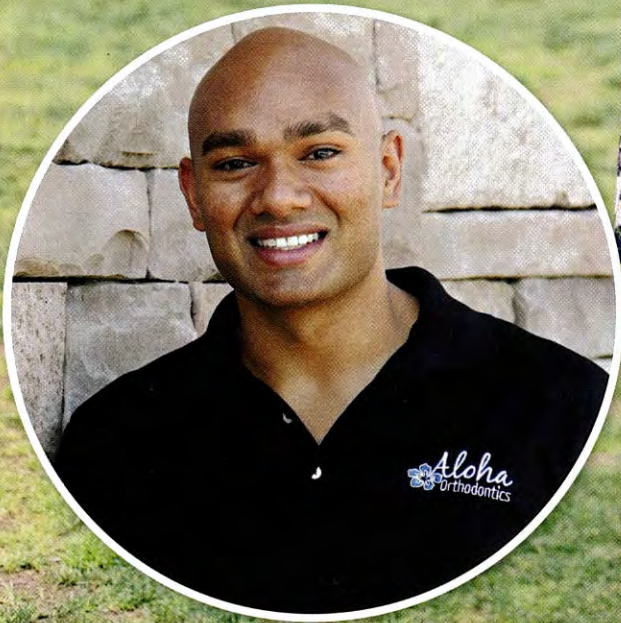


meet your
